Q. 32. But why art thou called a Christian?

A. Because by faith I am a member of Christ, and thus a partaker of His anointing; in order that I also may confess His name; may present myself a living sacrifice of thankfulness to Him; and may with free conscience

fight against sin and the devil in this life, and hereafter, in eternity, reign with Him over all creatures.
