Q. 49. What benefit do we receive from Christ's ascension into heaven?

A. First, that He is our Advocate in the presence of His Father in heaven. Secondly, that we have our flesh in heaven, as a sure pledge, that He, as the Head, will also take us, His members, up to Himself. Thirdly, that He sends us His Spirit, as an earnest, by whose power we seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God, and not things on the earth.

Q. 50. Why is it added: And sitteth at the right hand of God?

A. Because Christ ascended into heaven for this end, that He might there appear as Head of His Church, by whom the Father governs all things.
