Q. 8. Are there more Gods than one?

Q. 9. How many persons are there in the Godhead?

**A. There be three persons in the Godhead, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost; and these three are one true, eternal God, the same in**

**substance, equal in power and glory; although distinguished by their personal properties.**
