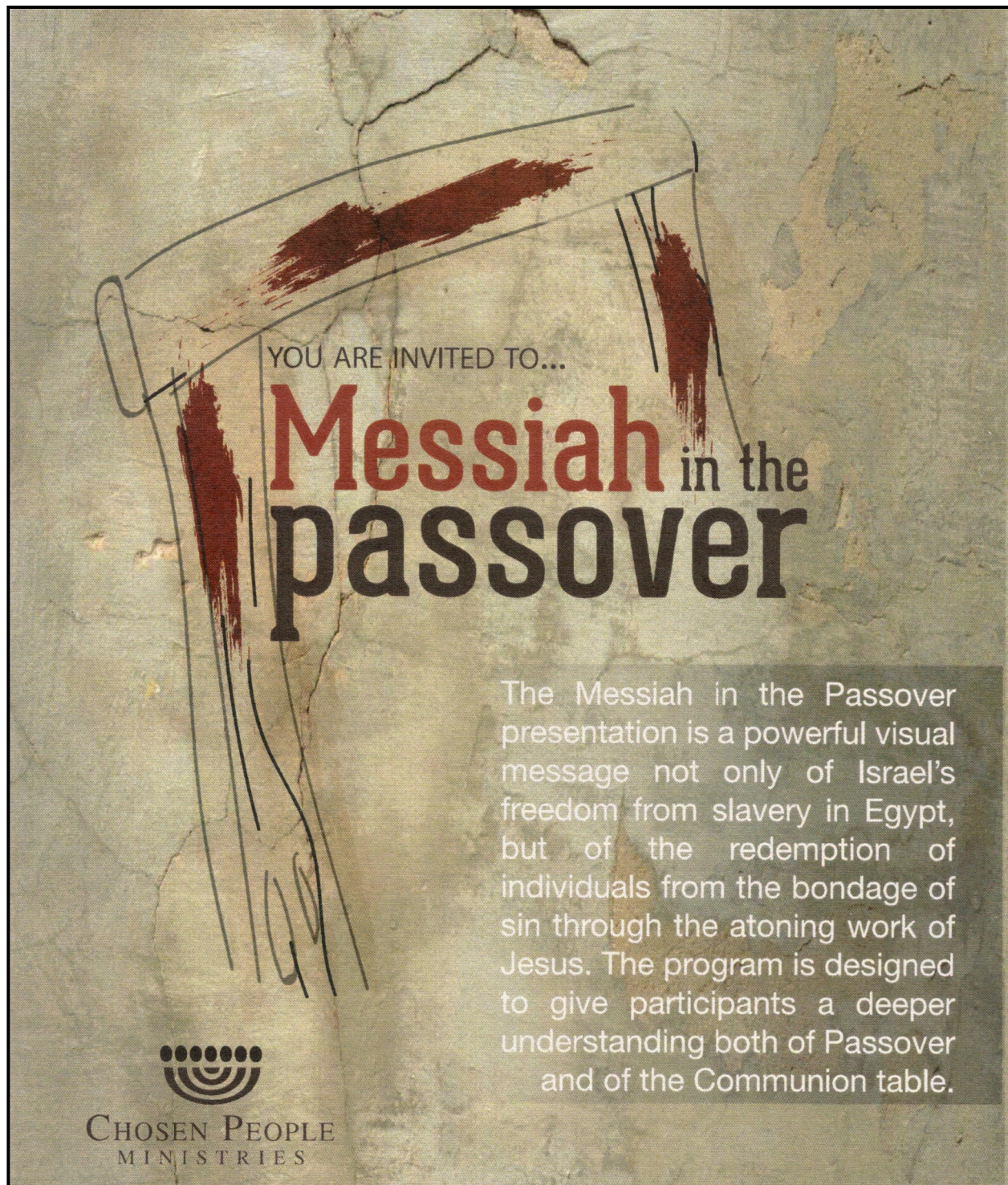

Juan Carlos, a native of Ecuador, received his MDiv and DMin degrees from Erskine Theological Seminary and was ordained in the ARP Church under Catawba Presbytery. From 2001-2004, he pastored in Mexico and in 2008 was commissioned as WW short-term missions coordinator. In February 2011, the Bonillas moved to Guadalajara, Mexico, where they established a church. In 2014, the Lord re-directed them to Spain and to the work of planting a church in Madrid. The Bonillas have two daughters: Esther and Sarah.
