As many of you may know, in 2021 David had the incredible opportunity to serve Slovak youth at the KECY camp in Rožňava, Slovakia with Josiah Venture. During his two-week trip, he was able to minister to the young people at this camp by teaching English, sharing his testimony, and building lasting, Christ-centered relationships. This summer, David and I have the opportunity to serve at this same camp together. After hearing the incredible ways that the Lord worked in David's life and in the lives of the students during his last

trip, I am thrilled to have the opportunity to join the team this summer. Our team will leave July 11th for Slovakia and spend two weeks in training, worship, and ministry there. As we prepare to leave for our trip, we appreciate your prayers and support and look forward to the work that the Lord will do.

In the coming months, please pray that the Lord would work in mine and David's hearts so that we can best serve the Slovak and Ukrainian youth at this camp. Pray that the Lord will open the hearts of these students and fill them with a desire to learn more about Him and to accept the ministry of local churches after our camp concludes. And, if you feel so led, we would be so grateful for your financial support as well. Our trip will require the purchase of plane tickets, training, and materials. This means that we will each need to raise \$2,240 in order to serve in Slovakia. If you are able and willing to support us financially as well as through prayer, we would be so grateful. 


