



Drew & Lauren Goodman - Uganda/SEED Ministry




Drew Lauren World ioined Witness 2015, Barry, serving Wales Christ W Church Presbyterian, revitalization church plant partnership with the EPCEW. As pastor, Drew was responsible for preaching, evangelism, outreach, and field development. In Aug 2023, the Goodmans transitioned to Uganda, where Drew is on faculty at African Bible University in Kampala. As part of the WW

SEED Ministry team, he also trains and mentors church leaders in nearby countries. Drew graduated from Moody Bible Institute, Reformed Theological Seminary, and received his PhD from Westminster Theological Seminary. The Goodmans have four children: Geneva - 14, Peter - 12, Luke - 10, Timothy - 5.

Summary of our First Semester

- African Bible University: Drew taught several courses and preached often in chapel and on Sunday evenings. He presented at an ABU conference which highlighted "Christ in all of the Scriptures." Next semester, Drew is scheduled to teach Greek, Biblical Theology, and Preaching.
- **SEED Rwanda**: Drew will be with our SEED/Erskine students in Nyabihu, Rwanda for Biblical Theology from 8–12 January (God willing).
- African Reformation Theological Seminary: Drew will teach Luke-Acts from January 15–19 and Romans from May 20–24 (God willing).
- Encouraging Ugandan Churches: Our family has enjoyed fellowship at a local Presbyterian church (RCEA Reformed Church in East Africa). Drew was invited to attend Presbytery meetings, to get to know others in the denomination, and to participate in training new officers for the congregation. He preached at Kajansi Presbyterian Church (PCU Presbyterian Church of Uganda) and the Christian Faith Centre Church in the Kayunga District. We pray for opportunities to build relationships with churches, future students, and to encourage leaders.
- Lauren's Involvements: Schooling has continued with the benefit of many children and a large co-op on campus. Lauren hosts a group of young girls on Saturdays to listen to Bible teaching and discuss application. Lauren organized the first-ever Reformation Day celebration at ABU and has planned for the first week of January a short-term missions team which will feature an evangelistic dental clinic and sports outreach. As always, Lauren has been quick to make friends and enrich the community and the Church.

On Friday mornings, 6:45 AM, several men gather at Doug Wicker's home for a time of food, fellowship, Bible Study, and prayer. Pastor Seth leads an interactive study (currently *2 Peter*). Email Doug to be added to the weekly reminder.
