In 2021, the Brickeys transitioned to SEED Ministry (Serve by Educating, Equipping, Discipling pastors and church leaders in the Global South). Justin has a Master of Divinity Degree and Master of Theology Degree from Erskine Theological Seminary. The Brickeys have four sons: Alex, wife

One of the overarching themes from this year in ministry seems to be "unity." We have the privilege of partnering with churches in the US and around the world to see the Gospel of

Christ at work.


Internationally, we participate in a ministry all about unity: World Witness's SEED Ministry in the Global South. Justin has completed his Master of Theology degree from Erskine Theological Seminary and is now in the teaching rotation with our World Witness SEED Ministry team. Our team teaches in places with limited access to theological resources. SEED has partnered with Erskine Seminary to offer a Global Diploma, offering a dignified alternative to



a degree for faithful church leaders who lack educational formation for a full college degree. Our global partners on the ground in Pakistan, Rwanda, and other African countries, do the challenging and faithful work of gathering and hosting the cohorts of students, and we bring the teaching. Unity. It's beautiful to watch it all unfold by God's hands.

In fall of 2023 Justin enjoyed his first solo teaching trip to Rwanda, working with ministry partners of like-minded denominations. So far, 2024's schedule includes a week-long trip to Cuba in March with First Presbyterian Church of Columbia. This is not a SEED trip, but a short-term church-sponsored trip in partnership with World Witness's cooperative missionary, Paul Peppin. Next will be SEED teaching trips to Pakistan in April and Rwanda in June. Please be in prayer for Justin as he studies and writes the curriculum in preparation for these trips. Pray also that God will bless the hearts of our brothers and sisters in our partner countries.

On Friday mornings, 6:45 AM, several men gather at Doug Wicker's home for a time of food, fellowship, Bible Study, and prayer. Pastor Seth leads an interactive study (currently *2 Peter*). Email Doug to be added to the weekly reminder.
