





(From their December Prayer Update)



Our family returned to the UK, and Christ Church Presbyterian reopened in August to continue opening God's Word to Barry, Wales. Few in town attend an evangelical church (possibly less than 500).

Our corner of Wales desperately needs a

renewal of God's work.

As the church is in need of rebuilding, our small attendance has begun to grow. Twenty-five volunteers from four Evangelical Presbyterian Church in England & Wales (EPCEW) churches supported a distribution of thousands of church-invitation leaflets. Christians from other Barry churches attended to



give us a jump start. We welcomed 20 different visitors in the first two months. We hope to receive into membership several regular visitors who have recently moved into the area.

We reintroduced a well-attended outreach, Toddler Time, and have made dozens of new friends in Barry. Some have suggested interest in attending church services. Lauren loves to befriend other women and teach children about Christ. Soon we will introduce a street-based evangelistic book table and coffee outreach. We offer evangelistic Bible studies to anyone interested.
